1. Progress Update and Roadmap

JW introduced herself and walked through the changes to the roadmap from last month's session.

The Team are targeting 24th April for ISO / DTL, and are finalising drops throughout the year, aligning with UK Link changes where necessary. These dates will be communicated as soon as they are agreed.

The launch activities will follow a similar approach to previous releases:

- Prior to release there will be UAT walkthroughs these will be scheduled through
 Eventbrite
- Training material will be released and available prior to the release
- FAQs will be updated to reflect any new questions that have been received



- There will be communication to users providing launch dates and information
- There will be a daily open customer dial in session from 10am to 2pm for the first week where there will be a member of the team on hand to answer or assist with any queries or support needed

The Roadmap is also going to ChMC and CoMC for discussion. We'll publish the roadmap on the CMS rebuild web page, as well as info on support activities for the April release, i.e. UAT walkthrough, dial in sessions for support and questions. We may do a UAT walkthrough at the next CFT too.

The CFG dates for the year are being finalised and will be sent out soon – just checking that we don't clash with other industry meetings

2. ISO Demo

RC Demo'd the ISO contact and process:

The ISO / DTL change pack is now approved following on the March's Change Management Committee meeting.

Questions from the demo:

- 1. If someone in the network got the info and set to dead at the same time as responding to us, would it create a problem?
 - a. No, we'd get a msg saying that its already set to dead and the contact would close.
- 2. Currently the ISO process seems to be an automatic valid resolution where the change is from CS to Live will that stay the same?
 - a. Yes it will stay the same. No more info needed it will flow through to uk link.
- 3. Could a warning notification be displayed saying that the query could not be submitted when a MSN gets pulled through from UK Link when doing Live to dead?



- a. We thought about that, ie pulling info through immediately, but for performance reasons it wouldn't really work. The validation would take time, so the screen would be locked. We decided it would be better for the validation to be done after submission
- 4. When trying to verify shipper I status, you choose from the drop down and the status is auto-populated, what if the existing mprn is capped / clamped and the shipper wants to set it to dead?
 - a. RC if its live and capped then it would still go through. We can add in capped / clamped to dead option
- 5. What is clamped?
 - a. It's when equipment is placed on a meter to stop gas flowing, it is usually due to debt or theft of gas. It's not common
- 6. Currently if an MPRN is extinct on UK Link we can't get it back. Would there be an option to move it form extinct to live?
 - a. There are checks to prevent it form happening. It would need to go through m number creation process
- 7. There is a problem with current training guides shippers misinterpret dead as not in use, and sometime ask networks to set them to dead erroneously. Set to dead should not be used for meter removed or not in use. Can you make it clear in new training material?
 - a. We'll spell out when it should be used. The drop down of valid reasons should act as a prompt too
- 8. A valid / invalid request for set to dead
 - a. ISO is only for the service pipe disconnection. Meter removal does not mean It should be set to dead

The launch of both contact codes is still planned for 24th April 2023.

3. Demo of Advanced search



RC walked through the advanced search for MPRN.

 - a. Yes We shall add that to the backlog

RC ran through some slides on proposed changes to RFA and DMQ, from which the RFA /CDQ change pack will be sent out to Change Management in April.

 - a. Yes they will be renamed too as they will have to run for legacy CMS and New CMS
- To clarify as we are discussing ADD and UNC which we do as bulk uploads is this
 making sure that everything is in place for New CMS so that bulk uploads will be
 available
 - a. Yes we want to get the file format cleared up so that bulk upload is available when ADD is launched


