**1948 The Gas Act** starts the nationalisation of the UK gas industry

1945

**1960 90%** of the gas supply still comes from coal

1955

**1956** The **Clean Air Act** encourages innovation to reduce air pollution

1950

**1966** Sir Henry Jones, chairman of the Gas Council Sir, announces the switch to **natural gas** 

1975

1980

**1964 First licences** issued to extract natural gas from the North Sea

1970

**1960s-1970s** Promotion of new **High Speed Gas** (gas from oil)
